

Confirmation Saint Name and Research Paper



It is a tradition in our diocese for Confirmation Candidates to choose a saint name. This guide will help you to research various saints and give you the necessary tools to choose an appropriate name. Upon choosing a saint's name, you will be asked to write a one page paper about the life of your chosen saint and why you decided upon that particular saint.

Why do we choose saint's names for Confirmation?

At Confirmation we deepen our commitment to the Church and our faith. As a symbol of this change in our lives we choose for ourselves a 'new name.' We look to the saints to be models for our own lives, and we know that we are able to ask them to pray for us. So we use a saint's name for two reasons:

1) We choose the name of a saint we want to be like.

2) We choose a saint that we want to honor, and who we want to pray for us.
